

Summary Cycling and Walking survey – 16 Feb 2021 via the HTC website.

460 responses, 236 people wanted to be kept in touch.

223 people cycle once a week or more. (48%)

447 people walk once a week or more. (97%)

332 people said that they would cycle from Highworth to Swindon if there was a safe cycle way with 260 saying that they would use it once a week or more.

327 people said that a lack of safe infrastructure stopped them cycling within Highworth.

The top 5 locations for cycle racks were

The priority for cycle path improvements was

Between Highworth & Swindon	34.41%	1104

The top 5 reasons which would encourage more walking were

Wider paths for wheelchairs or pushchairs.	8.26%	38
safe crossings	6.52%	30
dog poo	2.39%	11
more footpaths / pavements	2.17%	10
car speed	2.17%	10

A significant improvement to increasing the width of paths and restoring them to their designed width could be obtained by cutting back and removing shrubs that encroach onto footpaths and pavements.
